Thursday, 13 December
in front of Gwynedd Council, Caernarfon

The meeting begins in the chamber at 2pm. Before the meeting, The intention is to have a **3 minute** message from every school. This message will be read by a representative from the school. A short message is required to the tune that School opposes the present document, and asks the Council to reconsider their proposals. We need AS MANY AS POSSIBLE of these messages, by schools that are under threat and those that are not. We want to show the full scope of the support.

The Welsh Language Society will arrange PA and speaking equipment on the day. We are open to any other ideas to make it a fruitful and interesting protest. Bring the children with you, it would be good to have a choir from some schools – this would draw the attention of the Media. Make banners, posters and so on. It would be good to have individual letters from the children. Some have suggested a march. This too is a good idea.

Will you send me a message to indicate if you can come and a prepared message for the day, and if there will be a representative from the school to read it? The Society has erected posters already, and we have prepared posters promoting the Rally. Notice has gone to the local papers too. Keep the protest letters in the press – lots of people read them.

A hive of activity is already underway. We will do our best to convince the councillors!
